What is Kumamoto University's Spring Program?

The Spring Program offered by the College of Cross-Cultural and Multidisciplinary Studies at Kumamoto University was created to provide international students who have an interest in studying abroad in Japan with a chance to experience life as an international student at Kumamoto University.

Program Dates	February 15 (Monday) – February 24 (Wednesday), 2016
Number of Participants	Maximum 40 Students (if the number of applicants exceeds 40, a selection will be held)
Eligible Students	Students who are studying at universities with which Kumamoto University has agreement for academic or student exchange, and who have English language ability equal to or greater than IELTS level 5.
Program Contents	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Classroom lectures on Japanese life and culture• A Survival Japanese language course• First-hand cultural experience• Guided field trips within Kumamoto Prefecture• Interaction and exchange with Kumamoto's local community
Participation Fee	¥80,000 *Does not include transportation to or from Japan
Scholarship	Participants who meet the necessary qualifications may be eligible to receive a government scholarship of 80,000 Japanese Yen .
How to Apply	Please request the international office of your university to send your application by email or FAX by December 8 (Tuesday), 2015 .

- Payment of fees and awarding of scholarship will take place during orientation in Kumamoto.
- The scholarship is provided by the Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO). To be eligible, students must have a GPA greater than or equal to 2.3, and must not receive any other scholarships for this program which exceed 80,000 Japanese Yen. Please note that there are a limited number of scholarships available. Scholarships will be awarded based on your university's Letter of Recommendation.
